
Dear Minority Leader Pelosi:

Congratulations to you and the voters who created the majority for the Democratic Caucus in the House of Representatives. For these reasons, SEIU supports your continued leadership as Speaker of the House and is eager for the opportunity to work with you and all of Congress to create an economy and democracy that works for all of us, not just wealthy special interests.
